## **TWO NEW COVID-19 CASES TODAY**

The new cases do not have to be contact-traced, as they have not been on site during their infectious periods, therefore are no risk to anyone on site.

As always, local infections, particularly in our community, is a reminder to us all that COVID-19 is a reality and our children and staff are best protected with masks, good hygiene, vaccination (age 12 and above) and social distancing etc.

Moving forward, please get tested if you or your child develop even the mildest of symptoms (or have been to an exposure site / identified as a PCC) and isolate until you have a negative result – just to be safe.
