

CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19 AT BIG HILL PRIMARY SCHOOL

Dear Big Hill Parents, Guardians/Carers and Broader Community,

Today our school was advised that a confirmed COVID-19 case attended class on Friday, 15th October, 2021 (Day 0). The case became unwell over the weekend and has not been back on site for schooling since.

If your child has been deemed a PRIMARY CLOSE CONTACT (PCC), you will have had a call from me today outlining what to do, including the need to test and isolate immediately and follow the advice of THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DH).

As the required contact notification is complete and all potential PCCs contacted, we can continue to welcome all students (except for PCCs) back on site tomorrow, which is in line with the current advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer. Additional cleaning is occurring overnight in readiness for the return of students tomorrow. Remember also mask encouraged for Prep – Year 2 and mandatory indoors for Years 3-6.

Finally, here's hoping our student and family exposed to COVID-19 are doing well at home, make a speedy recovery and are back on deck at Big Hill PS in a few weeks.
