

RETURN TO ON SITE LEARNING

Following the announcement that the 5 day Lockdown will end tonight at 11:59pm, we are excited to announce that we will welcome ALL children back on site TOMORROW, Thursday, 18th February. Big Hill PS will be back in action as normal, including our OSHC service.

Please return children with any learning materials sent home last Friday or this week.

On site arrangements remain the same - visitors to the school must wear a mask when unable to social distance 1.5m. This is often the case in the foyer of our school.

Children who are feeling unwell with any symptoms of COVID-19 (runny nose, cough, fever, sore throat etc) must stay at home and get tested - isolating until a negative result is received. Children at school with symptoms will have to be sent home under current regulations.

Drinking fountains remain in use, however, individual drink bottles are preferred.

Finally, a big thank you to our students and parents for stepping into remote learning this week so seamlessly. A big pat on the back to our staff who jumped to action at a moment's notice Friday afternoon - with some working all weekend to prepare for the week. Impressive.
